CARE AND MAINTENANCE GUIDELINES

Keep your Vallaria Hardwood Floor looking beautiful with basic routine care and a few common sense preventive measures.

VACUUM OR DUST-MOP ON A REGULAR BASIS

It's important to remove dirt and grit that can scratch your floor's surface. Vacuum, sweep, or dust-mop your floor on a regular basis, and as needed, especially in high-traffic areas where dirt and grit may be tracked in. Do not use a vacuum with a beater bar attachment, which can scratch a wood floor's finish.

CLEAN WITH PRODUCTS DESIGNED FOR HARDWOOD FLOORING

For deeper cleaning to remove dirt, grime, etc., use a floor cleaner specifically for hardwood flooring and follow label instructions. Be sure not to allow liquid—especially water—to stand on the floor for any length of time. If you have any concerns about what products to use, please contact your retailer or Vallaria Floors! Quality Assurance. Your Vallaria Limited Warranty does not cover damage done to your floor as a result of using improper cleaning products or methods.

PREVENTIVE MEASURES ARE IMPORTANT

A few common sense measures will help protect your floor from damage and make routine cleaning and maintenance even easier.

Place floor mats and rugs (without rubber backing) at entrances and heavy traffic areas, including children's play areas (to avoid damage from toys).

Wipe up spills immediately. Use floor protector pads under furniture.

Don't walk on your floors with spikes, shoes with rocks in them, high heels, or shoes that are in disrepair. Be aware that sunlight and exposure to light will affect the color of your floor. Rotate area rugs and any furniture that blocks light to minimize the difference in color across your floor.
